


Semaphore is a way for seafarers to communicate over distances, such as from one ship to another ship or from a ship to the shore. Semaphore flags are usually divided diagonally and coloured red and yellow to make them more visible.

To communicate with semaphore, a flag is held in each hand and arms are then placed in specific positions to represent the letters of the alphabet.
